## INTRODUCTION

The Joint Master Degree Programme in Public Administration (MPA) is organised by the Institute for Governance and Policy Analysis (IGPA) at the University of Canberra and the Faculty of Administrative Science (FIA-UI) at the Universitas Indonesia.

The program is launched on 30 October 2018 and allows students to undertake their first semester of the Masters program in Indonesia, the second and the third semester in Canberra and the fourth semester in Indonesia. In the first year, the program will provide participants with an in-depth knowledge of public administration and public policy-making in Indonesia. During the second year, the MPA component will include advanced knowledge and skills in governance, policy analysis and leadership. There will also be a dissertation component which will allow participants to investigate a wicked governance problem from both an academic and applied perspective.

### THE EDUCATIONAL AIMS OF THE PROGRAM ARE:

- to support the international modernising civil services agenda through enhancing the study and practice of policy formulation and delivery within public organisations;
- to foster strategic thinking for the creation of public value;
- to develop skills that underpin this agenda, including those of analysis, evaluation, use of evidence, problem solving, communication and the management of change;
- to explore and understand the international context of public administration, through awareness of the role of global trends and institutions, the scope for learning internationally and for the transfer of ideas;
- to link theory and practice in relation to the delivery of public services through a problem-solving centred approach to learning that aids professional development;
- to promote shared learning across sectors (public, private, non-profit) and internationally; and,
- to offer flexible forms of study which enhance work-based learning.



# ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS TO UI

1. Candidates are Indonesian civil servants (Aparatur Sipil Negara/ ASN or Pegawai Negeri Sipil/PNS) who have worked for a minimum period of 2 years or are an Indonesian citizen. Maximum age of candidates on December 31 in the year of registration is 35 (thirty-five) years. An exception is given to ASN or PNS with functional position as Researcher/Medic/Paramedic/Teacher/ Lecturer, maximum age of candidates on December 31 in the year of registration is 42 (forty-two) years.
2. Candidates must apply through SIMAK test (UI's Admission Test) and have a minimum score of 6.5 for IELTS with a minimum writing score of 6.5 and no sub-score below 6.0; or IBT TOEFL: minimum score of 90 for the internet-based test with a minimum of 24 in writing.
3. Successful candidates, who are willing to get funding support, will be reviewed by the responsible Sponsor.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS TO UC

1. Applicants must have a degree or equivalent as approved by the University's Admissions Committee and meet all UC entry requirements for the Master of Public Administration programme.
2. Candidates must apply through the UC online application system.
3. Candidates must meet UC English Language requirements for entry to the Master of Public Administration from University of Canberra Academic IELTS of 6.0 or equivalent, with no band score below 6.0.

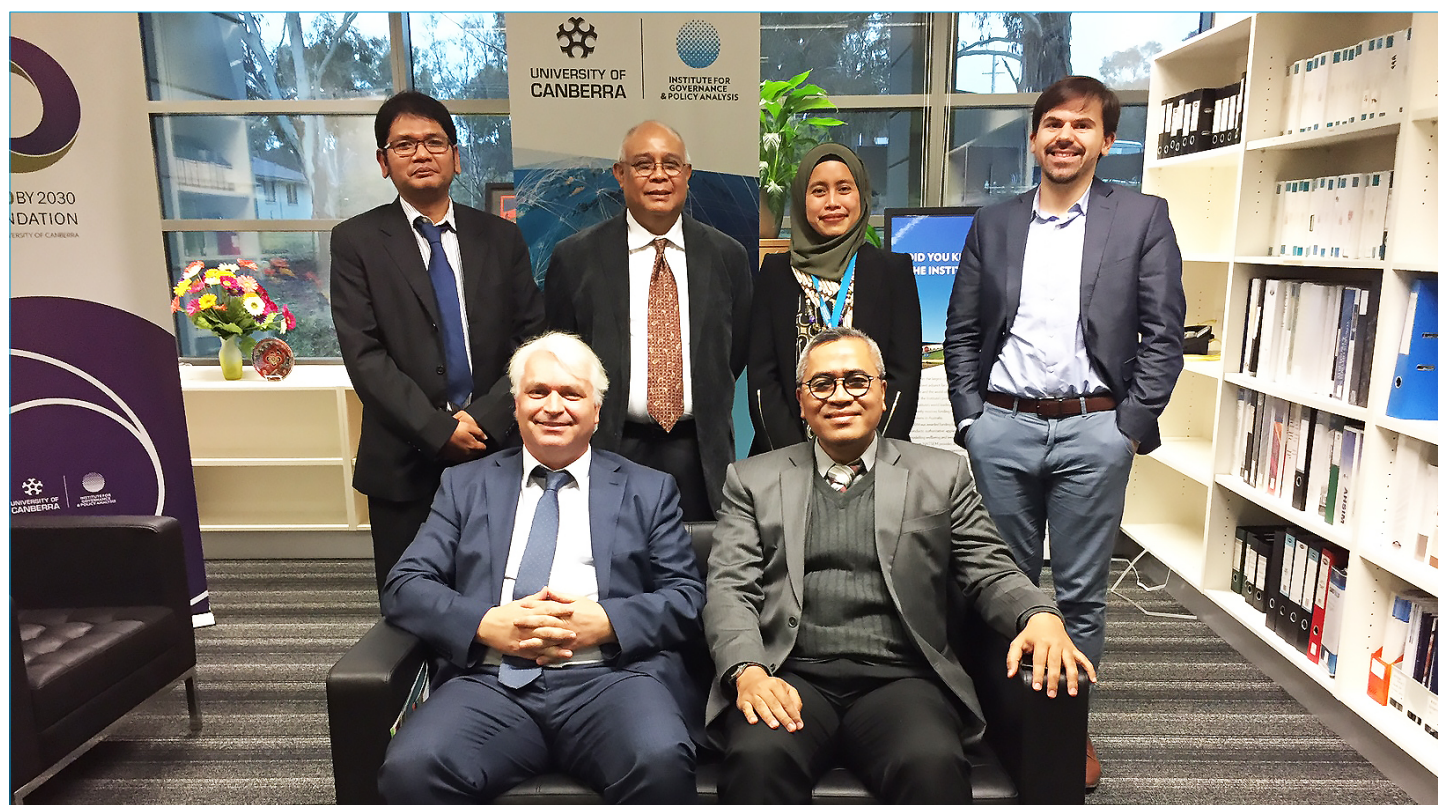
## ABOUT THE INSTITUTIONS

The Faculty of Administrative Science Universitas Indonesia (FIA UI) was originally one of the departments in The Faculty of Social and Political Science Universitas Indonesia (FISIP UI) . Since March 2015, FIA UI has three courses, including Business Administration Program, Fiscal Administration Program, and Public Administration Program. The faculty also conducts education for undergraduate (regular), extension and non-regular (parallel) programs. In the 2018 QS World Universities Rankings, UI is ranked 1st in Indonesia, 58th in Asia and 277th in the world, while it also sits among the Asia's top 201-250 universities in the latest Times Higher Education rankings.

The Institute for Governance and Policy Analysis (IGPA) at the University of Canberra was established in January 2014 to harness the research strengths of the former ANZSOG Institute for Governance (ANZSIG) and the National Centre for Social and Economic Modelling (NATSEM). The Institute conducts interdisciplinary research in governance and policy analysis to deepen theory, advance knowledge and improve practice, in a way that is of significance to scholars and practitioners in Australia and internationally. The core aim of IGPA is to create and sustain a world class research institution for the study and practice of governance and public policy. The University of Canberra sits among the world's top 251-300 universities in the latest Times Higher Education World University Rankings, further cementing the University's position in the top two per cent of tertiary institutions worldwide, University of Canberra also ranks in the world's Top 100 young universities (under 50 years of age) according the Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) rankings and in the Times Higher Education (THE). Further, through IGPA, the University of Canberra has the 1st rank for Public Administration for the whole Australia and top 22 globally according to the Financial Review.

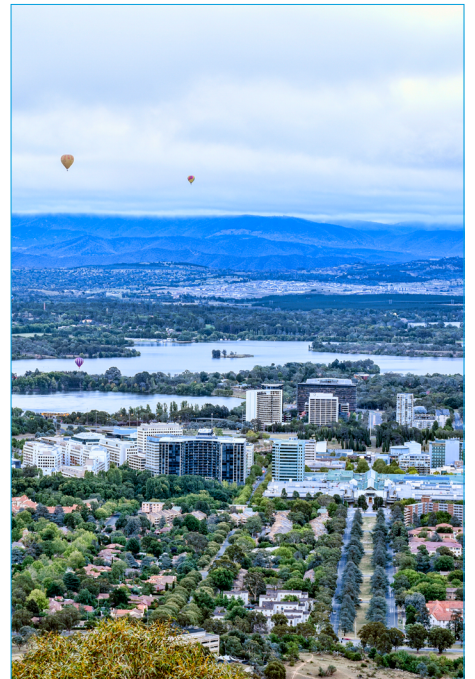
